




# 2.1 Age profile of participants with an approved plan (no. of participants)



# 2.2 Primary disability of participants with an approved plan




#### 2.3 The level of function of participants with an approved plan






#### 4.1 Total annualised committed support by support category (%)




#### 4.2 Total annualised committed support by primary disability (%)



#### 4.3 Total annualised committed support by age group (%)











#### 5. Average annualised committed support - most recent approved plans




## 5.2 Average annualised committed support by primary disability (\$)









# 7.11 Distribution of participants by annualised committed support band for age 7 to 14 yrs




# 7.12 Total annualised committed support by support category for age 7 to 14 yrs




