

Down Syndrome Australia ILC grant

The NDIA awarded an Information, Linkages and Capacity Building grant to Down Syndrome Australia in 2018 to develop a Community Inclusion Toolkit. The Toolkit supports inclusion of people with Down syndrome in the community.
