




















# 4.2 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by primary disability (%)




4.4 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an function score and an approved plan by level of function (%)






5.1 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by annualised committed support band




5.3 Average annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by age group (\$)






### 7.5 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 0 - 6 yrs
















## 7.21 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 15 to 24 yrs





# 7.22 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 15 to 24 yrs










# 7.29 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 25+ yrs




