

Transcript for Roll out of the NDIS in South Australia – introduction video

In 2016, the National Disability Insurance Scheme, also called the NDIS, will begin full roll out across South Australia.

By end December 2016, entry into the NDIS of children aged between 0 and 14 will be completed.

From 1 January 2017, the NDIS will begin to be available to young people aged between 15 and 17.

From 1 July 2017, adults aged 18 to 64 will begin to enter the NDIS based on where they live.

If you are aged between 18 and 64, visit ndis.gov.au/sa to find out when the NDIS will be available in your area.

Existing commonwealth and state based supports will continue until you are covered by the NDIS.

The NDIS is expected to be operating state-wide for all age groups by July 2018, ultimately providing support to about 32,000 people.
