As a child, 21 year old Tiana Dillon struggled to communicate with her family and peers, and retaliated against her mother Marilyn as a result. She was diagnosed with autism at age five and received little support to help her.

Tiana now receives regular therapy through the NDIS to build up her communication skills through visuals and sign language and is now able to communicate with her mother without any aids.

She is now also working two days per week at a local primary school, with her NDIS-funded support worker assisting her.
