Occupational Therapy Training for the NDIA

Home Modification - Advanced Practice and Application

Many NDIS participants report difficulty managing every day activities in their homes. For some this is due to poor technique, for others - a lack of equipment or minor home modifications such as simple ramps and rails. For a limited few there may be a need for complex home modifications: those requiring structural changes to the dwelling.

Whilst any Occupational Therapist is able to prescribe simple home modifications for National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) participants, the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) has introduced a process where the prescription of complex home modifications is limited to expert Occupational Therapists. These Therapists review the participant's functional performance and thoroughly investigate all options to assist them to access and use essential areas of their home prior to the prescription of complex modifications. Participants have a choice of these OTs from a list in each region and are assured that these therapists are experts in this practice area and have been trained in working with the NDIA ie. considering all alternatives, understanding reasonable and necessary and providing the justification documentation required.

This 2-day training package has been designed in collaboration with the NDIA to address the specific challenges and issues that have been identified for occupational therapists who wish to assess participants with complex home modification requirements and develop concept plans for NDIS participants. The program will be of value for any OT working with NDIS participants.

Completion of this training enables OTs to be eligible for the regional Interim Lists. Inclusion in the Lists is via invitation or an Expression of Interest process. All are therapists on the Lists required to attend this training. A Certificate of Completion will only be issued to those Occupational Therapists that attend the training and complete all required activities.

Participants will be expected to complete a range of pre and post-training readings and activities.

Advanced Practice and Application – 2 days

The training will focus on the practical application of the content covered in the Introduction to Practice workshop through a variety of complex case studies to consolidate learnings and apply workshop information to the NDIS practice framework.

Content includes:

- Further NDIA information about the framework for service delivery and expectations regarding recommendations and documentation for complex scenarios
- Strategies to research, review and select design ideas
- Feedback and discussion with NDIA senior staff reviewing recommendations developed
- Clinical reasoning in relation to challenging ethical issues
- Creative problem solving re: specific areas of the home and modification options addressing layout redesign and complex environmental barriers
- Use of telehealth for people who present with complex needs
