
# 2.1 Age profile of active participants with an approved plan (no. of participants)






# 4.1 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by support category (%)




# 4.3 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by age group (%)


# 4.4 Total annualised committed support for active participants with a function score and an approved plan by level of function (%)




# 5.4 Average annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by level of function (\$)



# 7.13 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 7 to 14 yrs




# 7.14 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 7 to 14 yrs



7.21 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 15 to 24 yrs





# 7.29 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 25+ yrs


