




### 2.3 The level of function of active participants with an approved plan






## 3.1 Month of first plan approval for new participants











# 4.2 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by primary disability (%)




# 4.3 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by age group (%)




# 4.4 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by level of function (%)





# 7.7 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by annualised committed support band for age 0 - 6 yrs















7.19 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 15 to 24 yrs











7.25 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 25+ yrs




