






# 2.1 Age profile of participants with an approved plan (no. of participants)






# 2.3 The level of function of participants with an approved plan













### 4.1 Total annualised committed support by support category (%)




# 4.2 Total annualised committed support by primary disability (%)



#### 4.3 Total annualised committed support by age group (%)




#### 4.4 Total annualised committed support by level of function (%)






# 5.2 Average annualised committed support by primary disability (\$)



#### 7.5 Distribution of participants by annualised committed support band for age 7 to 14 yrs





### 7.6 Total annualised committed support by support category for age 7 to 14 yrs








#### 7.12 Total annualised committed support by support category for age 15 to 24 yrs


