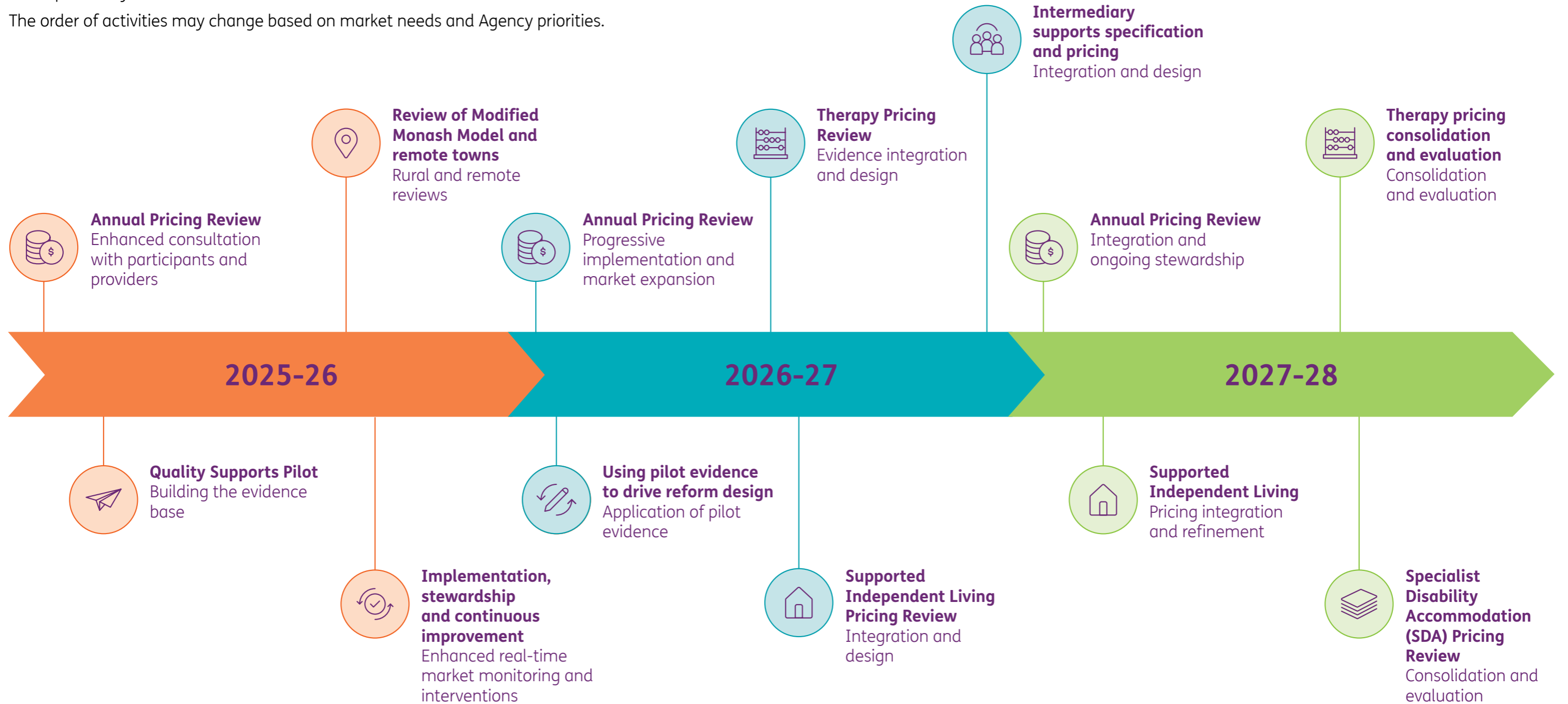


How to read this workplan

Quality Supports Pilots 2025-27

Annual Pricing Review: Core mechanism for Stewardship

Year 1: Immediate action and evidence building (2025-26)

This work develops the foundations for future pricing design.

Focus: evidence building, including the Quality Support Pilots, targeted market analysis and the 2025-26 Annual Pricing Review.

The order of activities may change based on market needs and Agency priorities.

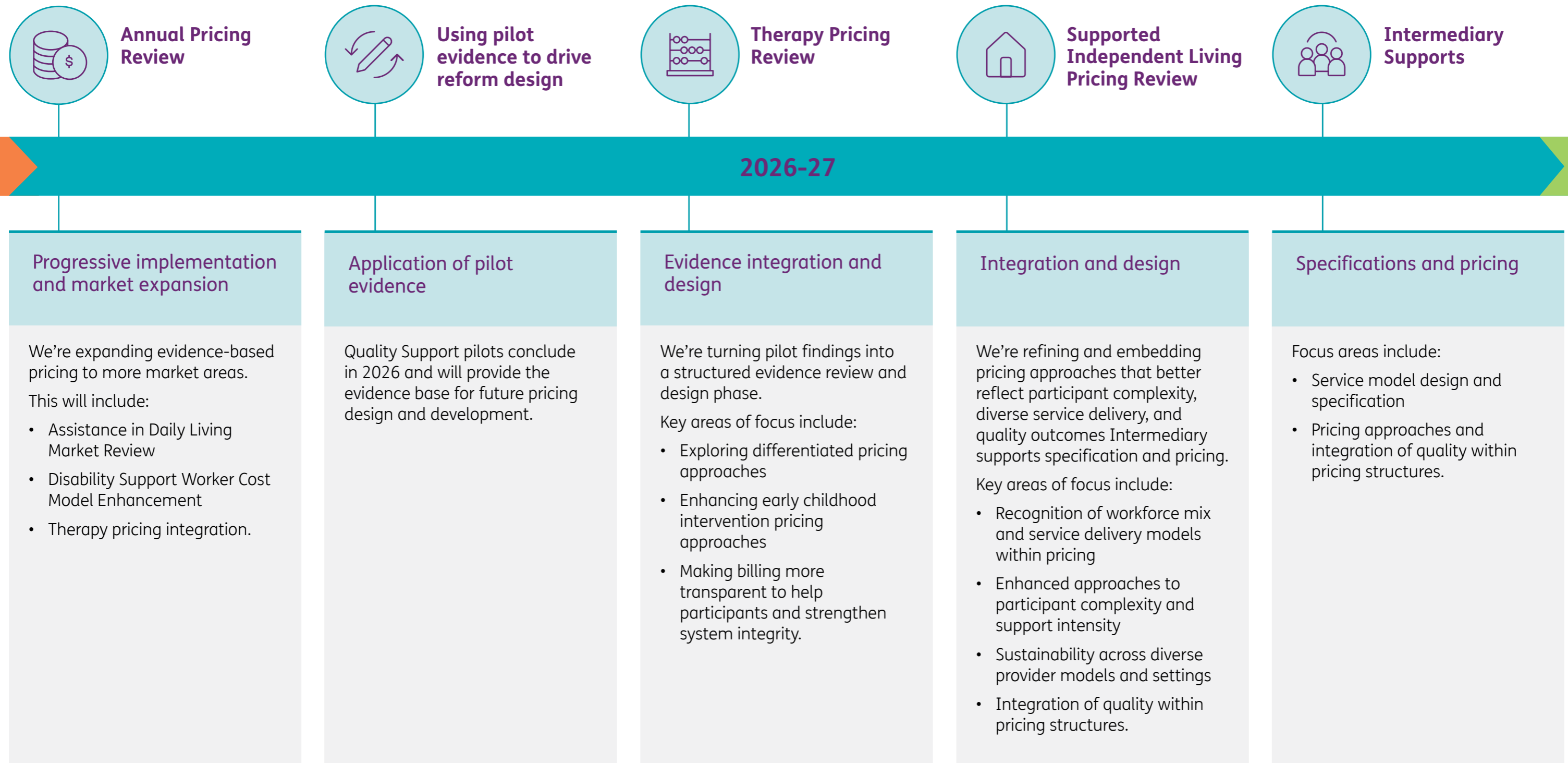


Year 2: Evidence-informed design and targeted implementation (2026-27)

This is the stage where pricing approaches are designed, tested and refined.

Focus: Formal pricing reviews and design work, guided by Terms of Reference informed by the 2025-26 Annual Pricing Review, pilot insights, administrative data and targeted consultation.

The order of activities may change based on market needs and Agency priorities.



Year 3: Implementation and refinement (2027-28)

Focus: Implementation and consolidation, embedding the outcomes of major reviews, monitoring early impacts and preparing future stewardship cycles.
