

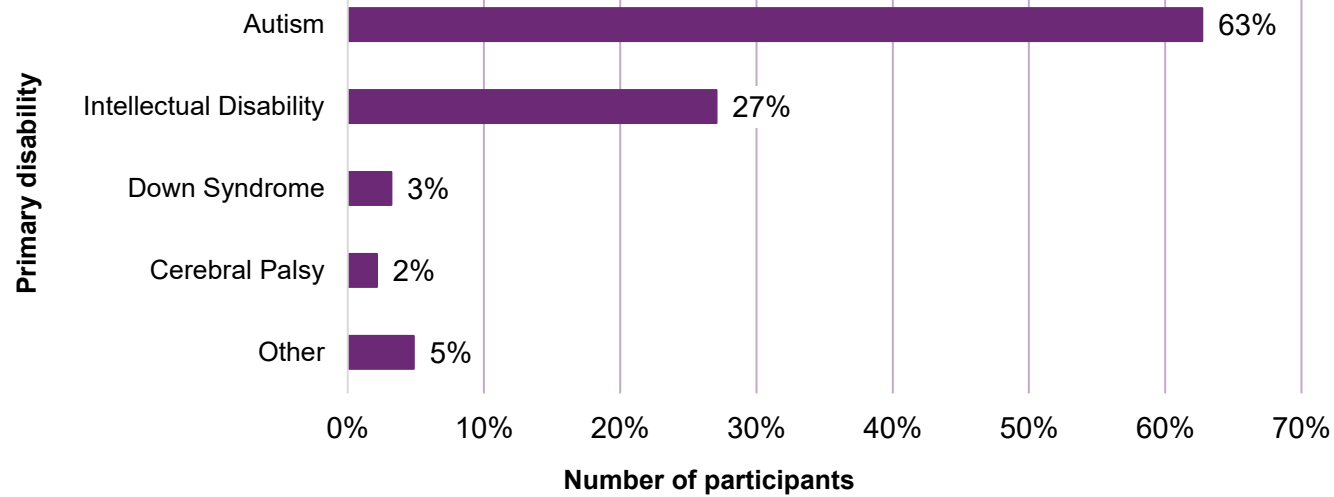

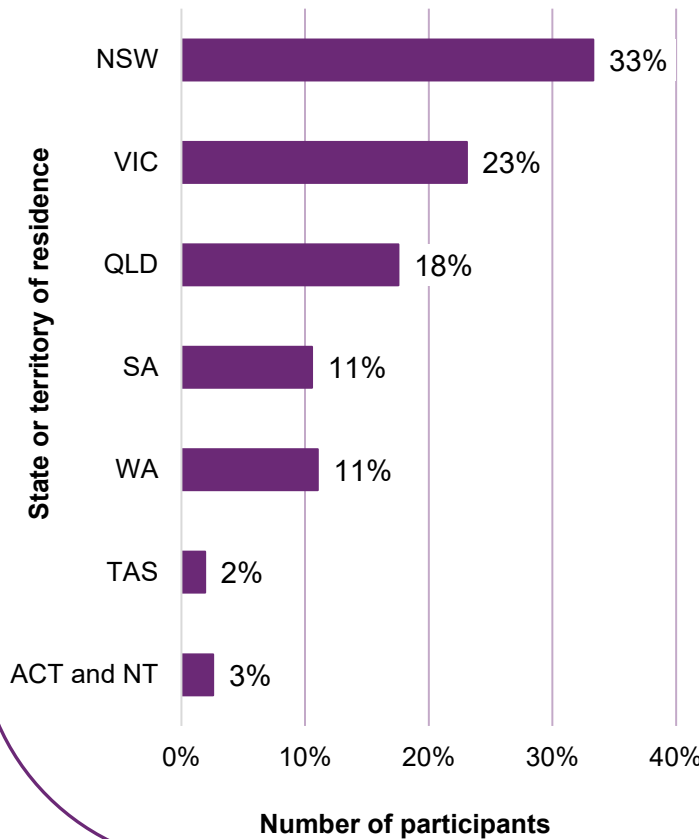

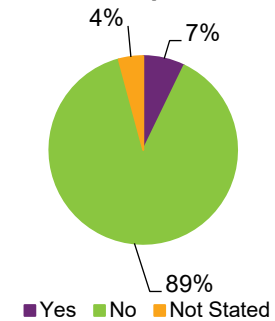
### Primary disability latest quarter



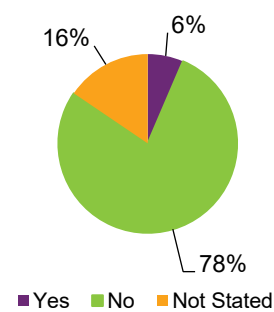
### State or territory of residence latest quarter



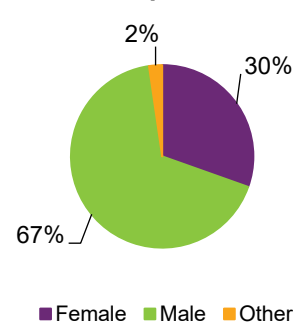

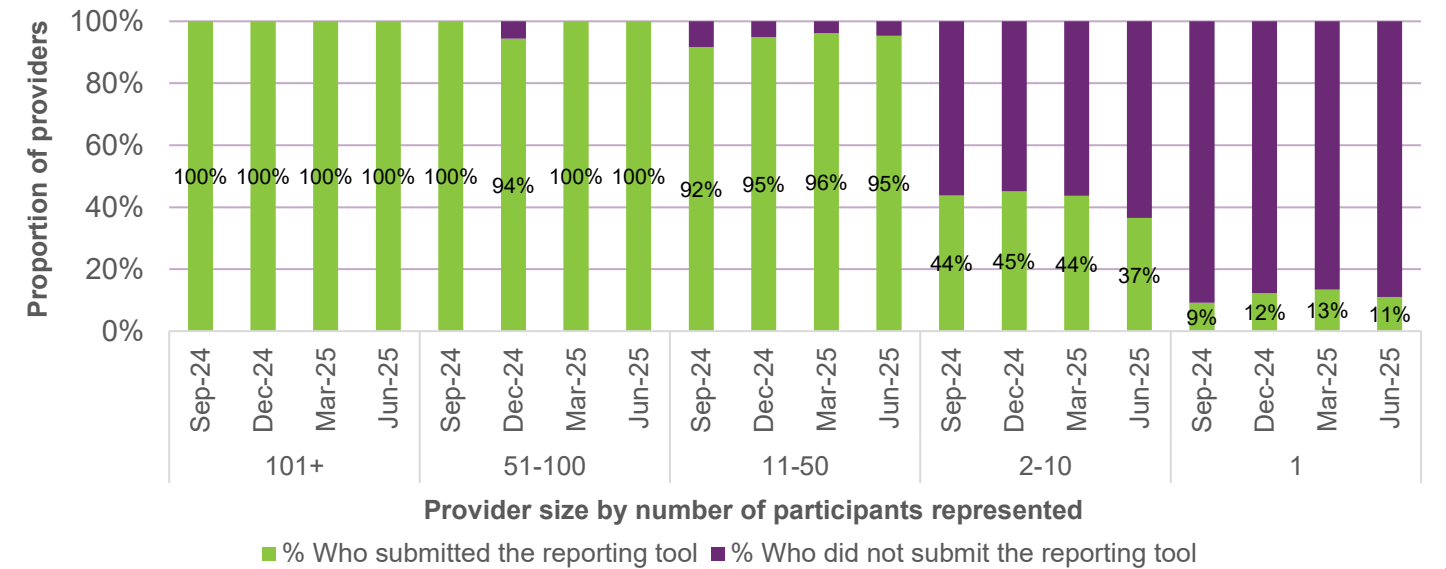

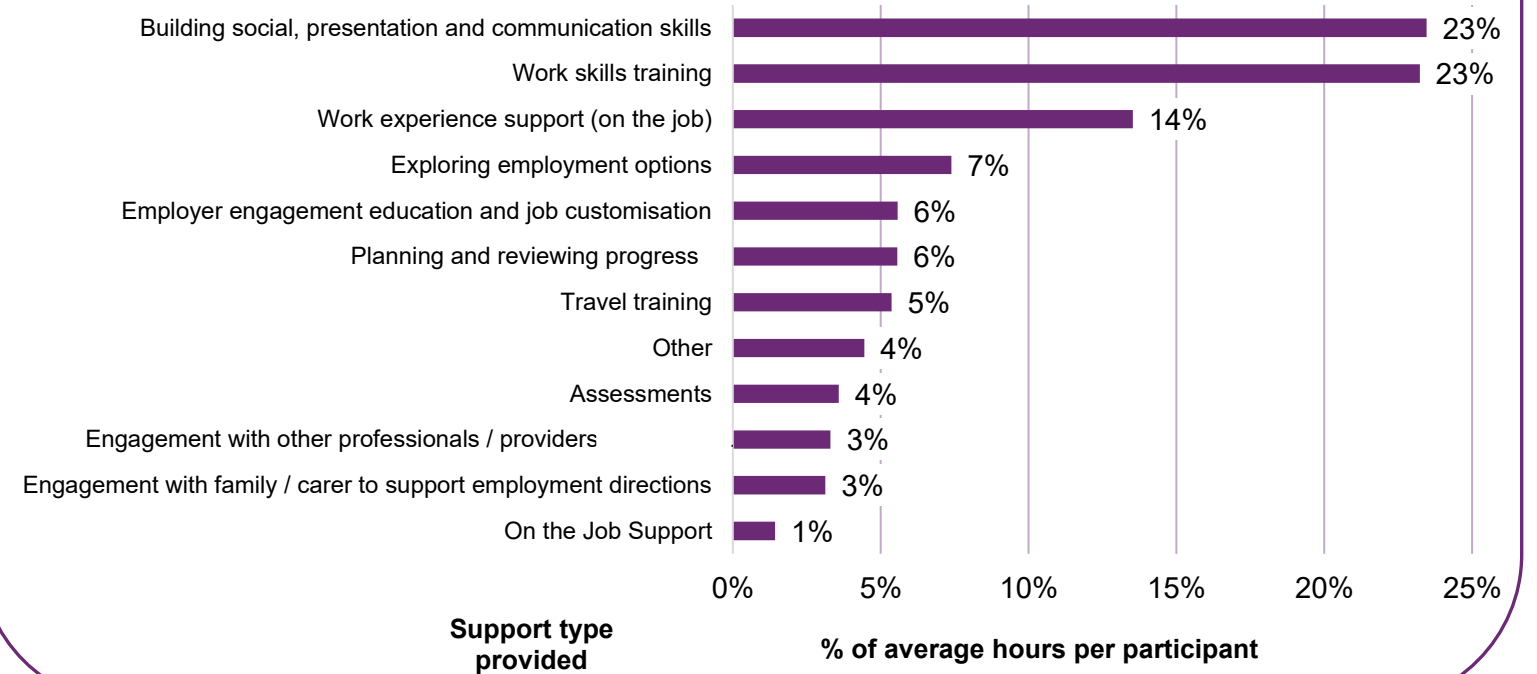

participants exited supports

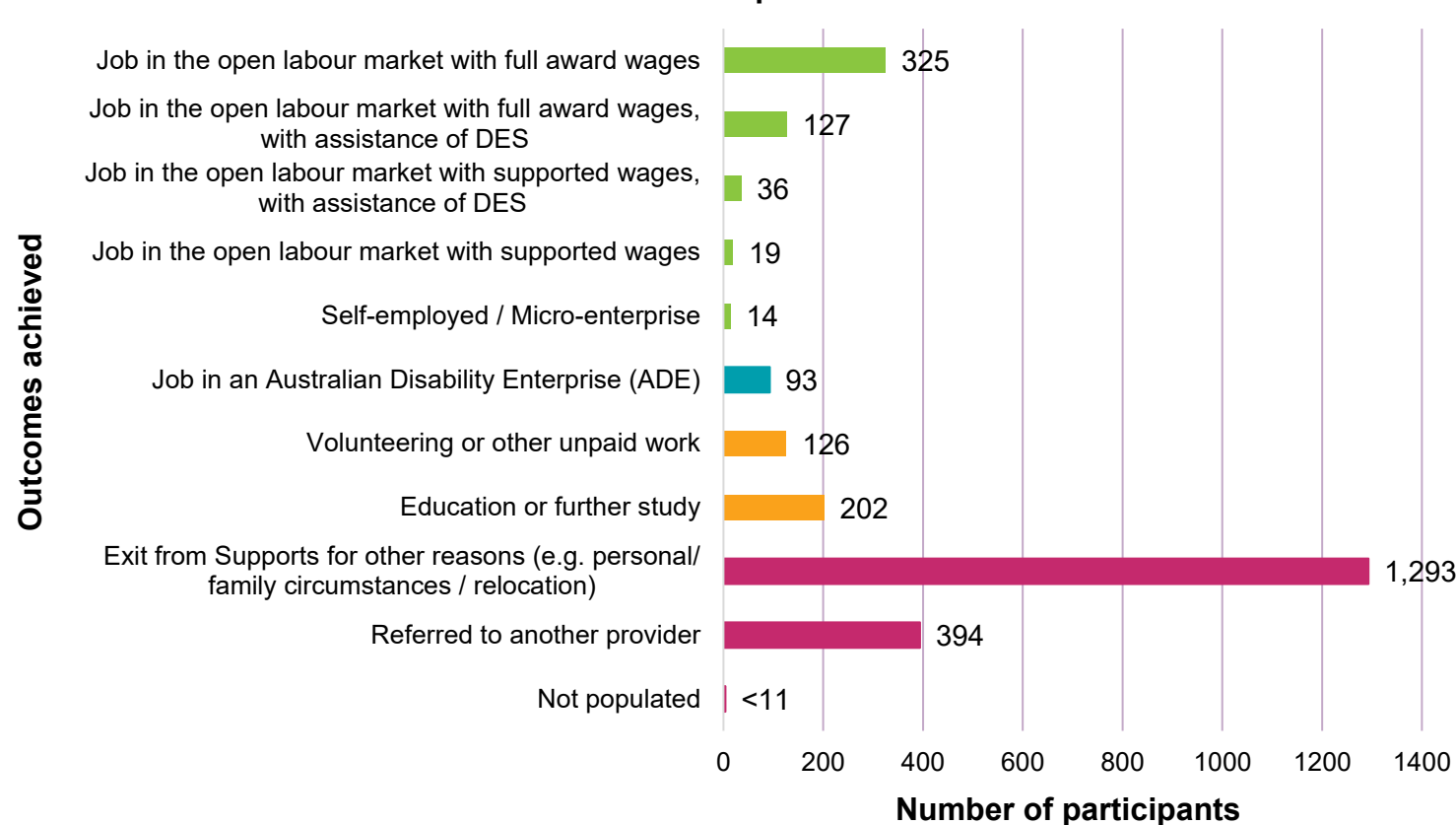
20% open employment

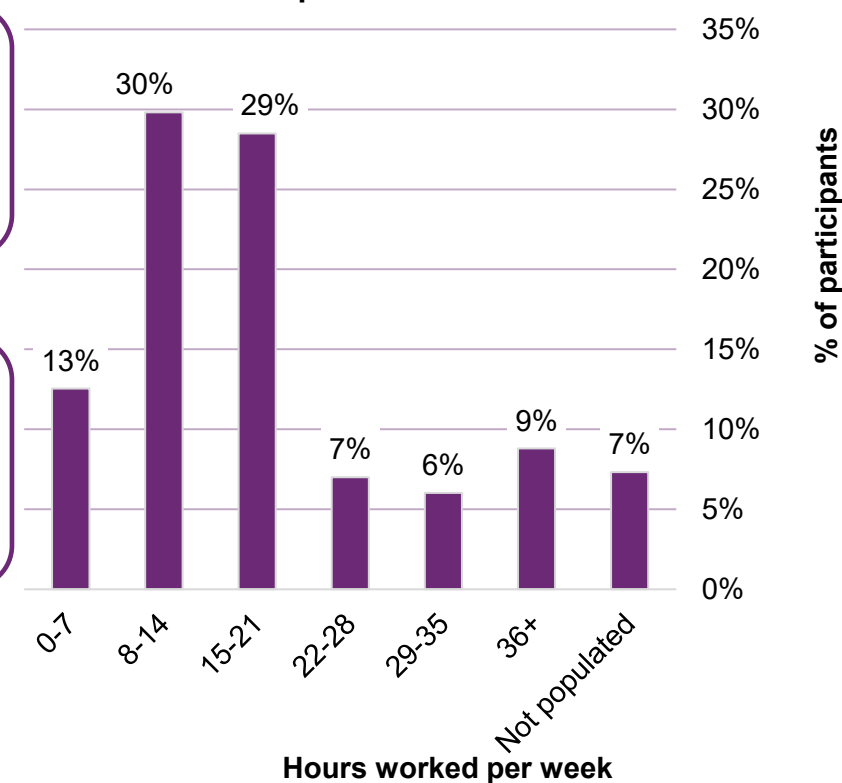
## Final outcomes (upon exiting employment support) for the 4 quarters



Of participants who exited supports with employment over the past 4 quarters, 71% worked up to 21 hours per week.

69% worked in Retail, Hospitality, Tourism, Trades, Manufacturing, or Operation.
