NDIS Growth

6,553 people in the Australian Capital Territory are **benefiting** from the NDIS

94% of families/carers of participants aged 0 to school age feel the NDIS is **supporting their child's development**

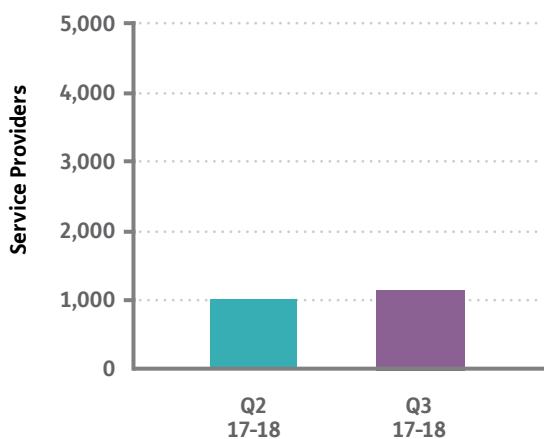
75% of families/carers of participants aged 0 to 14 are able to help their child **develop and learn**

76% of participants aged 25+ say the NDIS has helped with **daily living**

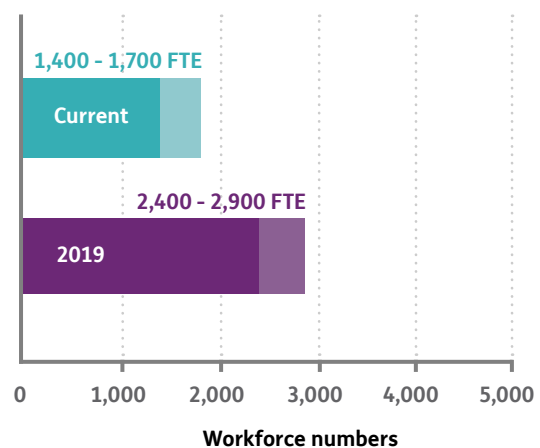
\$15.7m has been committed to **Assistive Technology** in the Australian Capital Territory
