1,363 Tasmanians accessing support for the **first time**

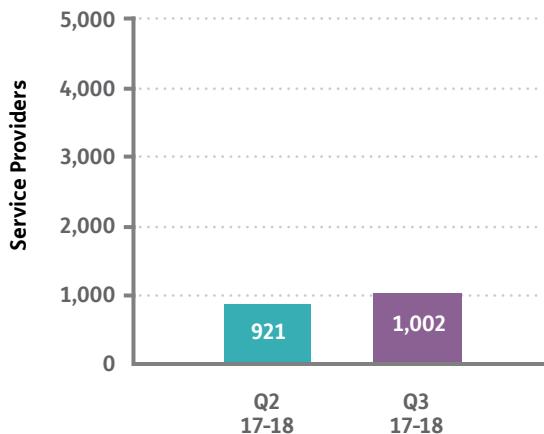

\$3.2m has been committed to **Assistive Technology** in Tasmania

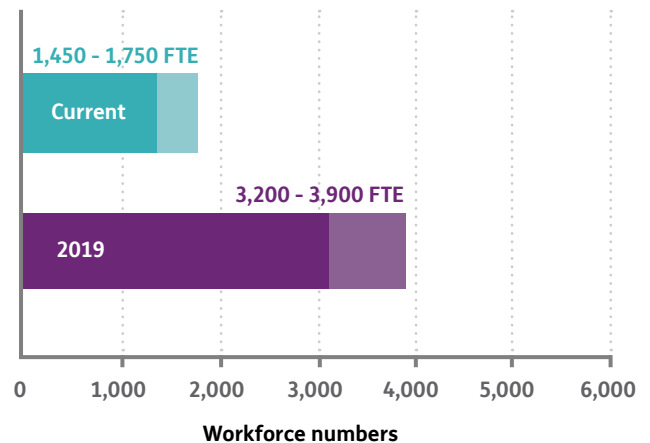
