We aim to boost job opportunities for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. We do this in a number of ways.

Indigenous apprenticeships

The [Indigenous Apprenticeships Program \(IAP\)](#) is a 12-month entry level program run by Services Australia.

This program provides tailored learning, based on academic and cultural needs.

Program aims and benefits include:

- a permanent, full-time job starting at APS3 level then moving up to the next APS level when you complete the program
- studying at the diploma level, with a range of specialisations offered
- an apprenticeship support and mentor program
- a competitive salary, superannuation and employment conditions.
