#### **Autism Advisory Group**

The <u>Autism Advisory Group</u> was established in 2018 to provide a strong voice on behalf of people with autism who are participating in the NDIS.

### **First Nations Advisory Council**

The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) and First Peoples Disability Network (FPDN) have jointly established a First Nations Advisory Council.

First Nations Advisory Council members are First Nations advocates and include First Nations people with lived experience of disability.

#### **Industry Chief Executive Forum**

The purpose of the <u>Industry Chief Executive Forum (ICE)</u>, formerly the Industry Reference Group (IRG), is to advise on improvements to the NDIS, which support development of a competitive market with innovative supports and services, and empower participants to pursue their goals in inclusive communities and workplaces

### **NDIA Mental Health Sector Reference Group**

The first meeting of the NDIA Mental Health Sector Reference Group was held in 2014.

#### **Participant Reference Group**



The <u>Participant Reference Group (PRG)</u> consists of 23 participant and carer representatives across Australia.

## **Pricing Reference Group**

The <u>Pricing Reference Group</u> was established in response to the Independent Pricing Review (IPR) commissioned by the NDIA Board to address pricing issues raised by participants and providers. The Group first met in October 2018.

# Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) Reference Group

The <u>SDA Reference Group</u> was established by the NDIA to support the development of the market, increase choice and control for participants, and ensure the long-term viability of SDA investments under the NDIS.
