The [Internship Program - Australian Network on Disability](#) offers practical paid work experience for students or recent graduates with a disability.

The internship is for a maximum of 152 hours of paid employment, as APS2 employees.

Our participation in this program provides the students with meaningful work experiences. More importantly, it allows managers and supervisors at the NDIA to develop their skills in supporting staff with disability and become disability confident.
