The Summary report includes details of innovative approaches that:

- would support a more timely supply of assistive technology (AT)
- improve sustainability through reduced landfill and waste
- provide greater price transparency that gives confidence for families to explore AT options.

This work builds upon the [Joint Standing Committee \(JSC\)](#) recommendations for better access to refurbished AT and the need to prioritise adaptable AT solutions for children, whose needs change as they grow.
