If you are impacted because of your disability or you need urgent repairs or replacement of assistive technology, the NDIS National Contact Centre will prioritise these requests.

Financial support

Those affected by the flood may be eligible to access the Australian Government Disaster Recovery Payment and the Disaster Recovery Allowance. More information is available on the [Services Australia website](#).

In Victoria, those impacted may also be able to access the Personal Hardship Assistance Program, which is a one-off payment to help you and your household access essential items like emergency shelter, food, clothing or personal items.
