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Consent forms

If you want to arrange for us to give information to others, or for other people to do things on your behalf, you need to give us consent. We accept both written and verbal consent and there are consent forms you can use.

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Sharing participant information

The NDIA has introduced an Information Sharing Protocol to clarify the process for state and territory government agencies requesting information from the NDIA.

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Access to information

You have rights under law to access your personal information and the NDIA can only refuse access in certain circumstances. There are different ways you can access your personal information held by the NDIA.

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Representatives, Lawyers, compensation payers and insurers

For participants' representatives If you believe the participant(s) who you represent may be impacted by the compensation provisions, please contact us on 1800 800 110 or send an email to the Compensation Recoveries Branch at compensation@ndis.gov.au. Please note you will be required to demonstrate you have authority to act on behalf of the participant. If you cannot demonstrate that you have authority to act on behalf of the participant then we will be unable to disclose any information to you. If you have authority to act on behalf of the participant, we may ask you for information about the participant's...

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Allied health practitioner students and provisional psychologists

Providers should talk with participants about how Allied Health Practitioner (AHP) students, provisional psychologists or Allied Health Assistants (AHA) can contribute to achieving participant outcomes.

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Recovery, compensation reduction amounts and special circumstances

Compensation reduction amount and your NDIS plan The NDIS is designed to complement, not replace, existing compensation arrangements for personal injury. This means the NDIS won't duplicate funding for the types of supports provided for in your compensation payment. It also means your NDIS plan can focus on providing other funded supports that may not be covered by a compensation claim. If your compensation payment includes funding for the types of supports that may also be funded by the NDIS, then the funding in your NDIS plan may be adjusted.
